O R D E R

The Director of the Office of Lawyers Professional Responsibility has filed a petition for disciplinary action alleging that respondent Zachary D. Schmoll has committed professional misconduct warranting public discipline. The petition alleges that respondent made and enforced an employment agreement that restricted the right of a lawyer to practice after termination of the relationship. *See* Minn. R. Prof. Conduct 5.6(a). The employment agreement required the lawyer to pay a marketing cost penalty for certain clients who chose to be represented by the lawyer after their employment with the firm ended.

Respondent and the Director have entered into a stipulation for discipline. In it, respondent and waives his procedural rights pursuant to Rule 14, Rules on Lawyers Professional Responsibility (RLPR), waives his right to answer, and unconditionally admits the allegations of the petition. The parties' joint recommendation for the appropriate discipline includes that respondent receive a public reprimand and reimburse the marketing cost penalty that was paid by or on behalf of E.S.

After the stipulation was filed, Schmoll informed the court that the full amount owed under the stipulation has been paid.

We have independently reviewed the file and conclude that the appropriate discipline is a public reprimand.


Based upon all the files, records, and proceedings herein,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. Respondent Zachary D. Schmoll is publicly reprimanded.
2. Respondent must pay \$900 in costs pursuant to Rule 24(a), RLPR.
